
Centralia, KS

On May 17, 1980, she married Leroy Francis Becker, and they continued to live in Centralia. They enjoyed traveling and took many trips. Leroy passed away May 1, 1988, in Laramie, Wyoming on a bus trip. Winnie continued to live in Centralia until April, 2011, when she moved to Country Place Senior Living Place in Seneca. She lived there until January, 2014, when she moved to Eastridge Skilled Nursing Facility.
