Lynn Robert “Bob” Vaughn, 84, of Hiawatha died shortly after arrival at Hiawatha Community Hospital, Tuesday afternoon, November 3, 2015.

Bob was born at McCook, Nebraska, November 10, 1930, one of five children born to Lynn and Sarah Jean Underwood Vaughn. The family moved to Idaho a few years before locating to Brown County where Bob had lived nearly all of his life.

A few years after her death, he moved to Maple Grove Senior Apartments to live until moving to Maple Heights Nursing Home recently.
