Lindell E. "Burr" Nolting, 83, of Nortonville, KS died Sunday, March 6, 2016 at the Midland Hospice House, Topeka, KS.

Funeral services will be at 11:00 am on Wednesday, March 9th, 2016 at St. Matthew's Lutheran Church, Nortonville.
