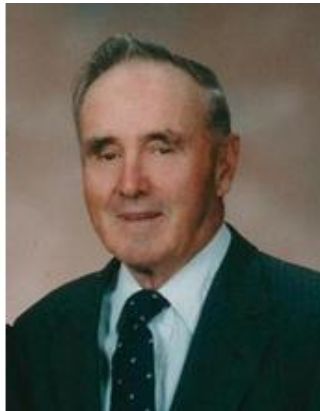


Axtell, KS
