Evelyn M. Henry, 85, of Goff, Kansas, died Tuesday, June 21, 2016 at the Eastridge Skilled Nursing Facility in Centralia, Kansas.

She was born in Seneca on January 8, 1931 to Francis H. and Florence M. Koch Feldkamp. In 1946, the family moved to a farm south of Corning she graduated from Bancroft Rural High School in 1948.
