During this time, he was instrumental in bring CR Industries to Seneca, KS which provided employment to many.

His only grandson who is currently serving in the military said it best: "Heaven got another angel. My grandfather, William Huerter passed last night. He was 91 years old and lived a great, long life. Respected by all who knew him as a honest, hardworking man. He taught me about hard work and doing a job right the first time, how to clean and gut a fish, how to hunt rabbit and quail, and most importantly about how to put your family first. Wish I could have been home to see you one last time, wish you could have seen me in my uniform, I know how proud you were before I left and you made me promise to come home safe. Miss, you so much already Granddad. Go find yourself a quiet fishing hole and have a great time."
