Kenny Simpson, 65, of Falls City, NE, passed away September 3, 2018 at Falls City. He was born November 8, 1952 at Falls City to Charles and Mary Lou (Coonce) Simpson.

Kenny served in the U. S. Air Force.

He married Constance Huebner on June 11, 1972 at Falls City. They divorced in February of 1983. He married Tami Sisk on May 30, 1996 at Oregon, MO.

Kenny was raised at Falls City and graduated Falls City High School in 1971. He enlisted in the U. S. Air Force following graduation.
