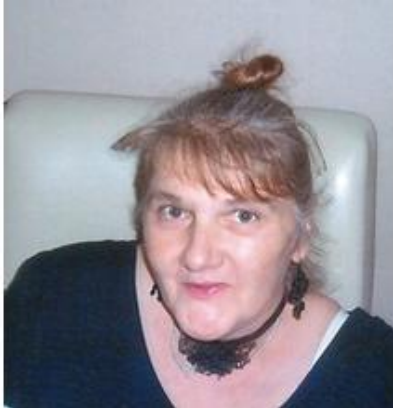


Hiawatha , KS
