He enjoyed teaching others how to play the organ including Ella Rake. He also taught piano to many students. He had been a music teacher in School District 430 for his entire teaching career until he retired in 1997. He freely gave of his time and talent to directing church choirs and the community choir. He was the choir director for the 1986 Centennial of Horton.

He was preceded in death by his parents.

Funeral services will be at 11:00 A.M. on Thursday, December 6, 2018 at the United Methodist in Horton, Kansas. Burial will be at the Mount Muncie Cemetery in Leavenworth, Kansas.
