## Seneca, KS

Junias J. Sudbeck, 94, of Seneca, died on Friday, March 22, 2019 at Stormont Vail Hospital in Topeka, Kansas.

Junias was born to Franz and Mary A. Olberding Sudbeck on October 6, 1924. He grew up on the family farm northwest of St. Benedict, Kansas and attended Haug Country School for six year before attending St. Mary's Grade School and graduating from St. Benedict High School in 1941. His father died when Junias was only17 years old.
