He enjoyed card games, often beating opponents at Rummy and entering into lively bidding in Some R Set, Pinochle and Hearts.

Willard had a deep passion for God and serving. He was active in the local church, the Gideons International, the prison ministry in Tecumseh and also served on many community boards. One of his favorite verses was 2 Timothy 1:12 "For this reason I also suffer these things; nevertheless, I am not ashamed, for I know whom I have believed and am persuaded that He is able to keep what I have committed to Him until that Day."

At home, surrounded by family, Willard entered his true, eternal home on Wednesday, May 27, 2020. He was preceded in death by his parents, toddler sister Ruth Binder, all four brothers, son-in-law Tony Taylor, many in-laws and friends.
