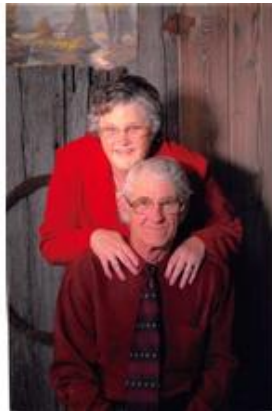


Effingham , KS
