She was an active member of the church, having served many offices, including Past President of the UMW, Sunday School Superintendent, Chairperson of the Administrative Council and Church Historian. Geraldine was former member of Netawaka Book Club, Women's Republican Club, Kansas Day Club, Holton Business Women and Board of Directors of Jackson County Nursing Home and later Medicalodge Jackson County. Geraldine and her husband were 4-H Club Leaders in the 1960's.

She married Noel Alan Sarensen on August 19, 1945 in Holton. He preceded her in death on February 25, 2000. She was also preceded in death by 2 sisters, Maxine Lambert in 1984 and Pat Comfort in 2010.
