Lewiston hosted its invitational track meet Tuesday at Auburn High School.

Sterling won the girls' portion of the meet in a close race, with 87 team points. Nebraska City Lourdes was second with 84, followed by Freeman with 79 points. Falls City Sacred Heart tallied 48 points for 5th place; Johnson-Brock placed 8th, HTRS 9th, and Diller-Odell 10th.

Individually, Liz Railsback of HTRS won the pole vault – with Sacred Heart's Ashli Jordan and Elizabeth Magdanz tying for second. All cleared seven feet.
