Atchison County Commissioners are beginning to research options to potentially provide employees with new benefits.

Commissioners Wednesday met with Hays Company for over an hour to strategically plan the process.

No plans have been chosen so far, but Commissioners hope a plan in place by fall and an implementation day on January 1, 2013.

Commissioners also gave authority for Emergency Preparedness Director Wes Lanter to hire an IT Specialist and Administrative Assistant for his Effingham office.
