Area TVL 8-Man Football Athletes Perform Well at All-Star Game

Area athletes shine in the Division II 8-man All-Star game this past Saturday. As the East squad featured 10 TVL players on the roster and was coached by Baileyville-B&B coach, Justin Coup.

While Mitch Engelken, ran for 233 yards on 20 carries with 3 TD's (longest TD run of 64 yards); his 233 yards unofficial All-Star game record.

Frankfort Wildcat, Tight end, Jonathan Keating also had a good offensive day grabbing 6 passes for 14 yards and a TD. East offense finished with 529 yards of total offense; while the West team was held to 198 yards of total offense.

Many other area TVL athletes competed in the Division II All-Star game; while 2 other area TVL athletes competed in the Division I game for the East squad, which lost their game 36-0 to the West.
