The driver of the pick-up was Ivan Henry, of Hiawatha. His passenger, John Russell, also a Hiawatha resident, is the one who suffered the minor injuries.

A utility crew was also called in, working to upright a power pole knocked crooked in the crash. A stop sign also suffered the impact of the collision, knocked to the ground from its foundation.
