No vehicles will be allowed to park along Oregon Street during the duration of the mill work. Any vehicles left in the construction zone will be towed at the owner's expense.

The milling is expected to be completed by Wednesday (September 12th), weather permitting.

Hamm, Inc. from Perry is the general contractor hired to resurface Oregon Street this fall. They will be in town shortly after the milling to complete the project.
