Sheldon Statewide Exhibit Opens with Friday Talk at Stalder Gallery (KTNC) - Railroads are the subject of the latest exhibit at the Stalder Gallery in Falls City. The Sheldon Museum of Art's 2012-13 Statewide Exhibition, titled "Railroads and the Making of Modern America," will open at the Stalder Gallery on Friday.
