New Hiawatha Recreation Director Hired

(KNZA)--A new Hiawatha recreation director has been hired.

Public Works Director Dave Grimm says Lowell "Grover" Hargrove of Hiawatha has been hired for the position, and will also serve as director of the Fisher Community Center.

Grimm says Hargrove is very well qualified and has some great ideas on how to improve the city's recreation system as well as community center.
