Atchison Co Bridge Cost Share Discussed

(KAIR) -- Discussions continue on what type and who will conduct maintenance of a bridge along K-74 highway in southern Atchison County.

Leroy Koehn of KDOT met with County Commissioners Wednesday about potential cost share options of a bridge two miles east of Potter that's set to be replaced.

Currently it's scheduled for replacement by KDOT in 2015, however, they are also offering to turn maintenance of that portion of K-74 highway over the county.
