Three Apply for Richardson Co Attorney

(KLZA) Richardson County Commissioners Tuesday reviewed three applications submitted for the position of Richardson County Attorney.

The appointee will fulfill the term of office expiring January 7, 2015.

Emergency Management Director Jim Gerweck also submitted job descriptions for the Director, Deputy Director and the Administrative Assistant of the Emergency Management Agency. Commissioners will review them and discuss them again July 16th.

Radio communications were also reviewed. A motion to move the radio equipment from the Humboldt Sheriff's Office to the Humboldt Water Tower and switch the FCC license to that location as soon as possible was also approved.

Commissioners also appointed Scott Huppert, Amanda Young, Brian Dixon, Deb Ebel and Pam Scott along with Commissioner Jim Davidson to a Health Insurance Committee.

Board members also approved writing a letter of support for the Sac & Fox Nation of Missouri in Kansas and Nebraska for a grant to fund a transit system.
