### Sabetha Gearing up for Rodeo

( KNZA )--The 58th annual Northeast Kansas Rodeo will take place in Sabetha Saturday and Sunday evenings.

Prior to the rodeo Saturday evening, a parade will be held in downtown Sabetha. A children's bicycle parade will be at 6 o'clock, and the main parade at 6:30.

All youngsters who decorate their bikes and participate in the children's parade will be eligible for a ticket to a rodeo performance.

Entries in the parades can be made up to parade day. Pre-registration forms are available at the Sabetha Chamber of Commerce office in the Sabetha City Hall, or online at [sabethachamber.com](http://sabethachamber.com)

Prizes will be awarded to the 1st, 2nd and 3rd place floats. Floats must be in place by 5:45 Saturday evening to be judged.

The annual rodeo, co-sponsored by the Chamber and Sabetha Saddle Club, will get underway Saturday evening at 8'clock and again Sunday evening at 7 o'clock.

In addition to traditional rodeo events, there will be a calf scramble for ages 8-12, and stick horse races for ages 7 and under.

Advance tickets, which are \$7 for adults and \$5 for 5-12 year olds, are available at Sabetha banks and Garrett's Country Mart. Tickets can also be purchased at the gate, but will be a \$1 more. There is no admission charge for children 4 and under.
