Leavenworth Educator To Challenge Jenkins

(MSC News)--A Leavenworth County native, and educator, has announced his intention to try and unseat Kansas' 2nd District United States Congresswoman Lynn Jenkins.

Chris Clemmons, a 2006 graduate of Lansing High School, plans to seek the Kansas Libertarian Party's nomination to make the run for the 2nd District Congressional seat.

Clemmons says, like his party of choice, his decision to run for office is also relatively new, developed when documents, indicating domestic spying by the NSA, became public.
