New Nemaha Co Fair Building Moves Forward (KMZA)--A bid has been accepted for the construction of a new building at the Nemaha County Fairgrounds in Seneca.

The county commission this week opened bids for the removal of the south fair building and the construction of a new 60 by 180 foot building in its place.

Following discussion, the commission voted to accept a bid from Steve Stallbaumer Construction of Seneca for the construction of the new fair building with the option of adding stepped concrete strips across the doorways for a total amount of \$124,200.
