Richardson Co Commission Votes to Accept Grant Funds (KLZA) Richardson County Commissioners approved the annual report to be submitted to the Nebraska Board of Classifications and Standards from Highway Superintendent Scott Huppert when they met Tuesday.

Huppert also provided updates on various road and bridge projects underway in the County.
