Falls City Life Chain held Sunday

(KTNC) - Eighty-four people participated in Sunday's "Life Chain" in Falls City. The "Life Chain" is an annual anti-abortion protest held on the first Sunday in October.

Participants stood silently along eight blocks of Harlan Street between 2:30 and 3:30 Sunday afternoon, holding signs with messages reading "Abortion Kills Children," "Adoption: The Loving Option," and "Abortion Hurts Women."

The Falls City Life Chain was part of approximately 1,800 similar events that were expected around the country Sunday.
