More than 30 Apply for Hiawatha City Administrator

(KNZA)--More than 30 candidates have applied for the position of Hiawatha city administrator. Mayor Crosby Gernon said during a special city commission meeting this week that around 36 applications were received by the October 7th deadline and include 8 to 9 strong candidates.
