Kansas Governor Sam Brownback's Water Conference will be held Thursday, October 24 and Friday, October 25, 2013 at the Hilton Garden Inn & Conference Center in Manhattan, KS. On Thursday the Governor will address a 50-Year Vision for Kansas water and meeting the state's needs. He will issue an Executive Order to begin work immediately on this priority resource.

The conference topics include:

- Meeting Kansas' water needs now and in the future
- Drought resiliency and conservation
- The value of water
- Reservoir sedimentation
- Water's role in developing the Kansas agriculture economy

A legislative panel is planned for Thursday afternoon. Day two will build on the water policy discussions with technical presentation posters and talks.
