New Holton USD 336 Superintendent Hired

(KNZA)--A former area school district superintendent has been hired as the new superintendent of the Holton schools.

Following an executive session, the USD 336 board of education voted unanimously Monday evening to offer Dennis Stones, of Sabetha, a one year contract at annual salary of \$81,300.
