Horton Man Sentenced on Felony Drug Charge

(KNZA)-- A Horton man convicted of possession of marijuana with intent to sell within 1,000 feet of a school has been placed on 36-months supervised probation.

Gabriel Whedbee was sentenced Monday in Brown County District Court on the felony charge.

Whedbee pleaded "no contest" to the charge in May. In exchange for the plea, two other drug charges were dismissed.

He had originally pleaded "not guilty" to charges in the case, and a jury trial had been set for this month.

Meanwhile, the sentencing for a co-defendant in the case, Horton resident Glen Scotton, has been continued to June 23rd.

Scotton pleaded "no contest" in March to a felony charge of possession of hydrocodone with intent to sell within 1,000 feet of a school. In exchange for the plea, another drug charge was dismissed.

The two men were among five adults and one juvenile arrested last October following the execution of a search warrant on a residence in the 1000-block of Central Avenue in Horton.
