Richardson County Board Reviews Architects Proposal

(KLZA)-- Richardson County Commissioners reviewed an agreement presented by Prochaska & Associates for architectural services for the construction of the proposed Richardson County Law Enforcement Center when they met Tuesday.

The 24-page document was reviewed but no action taken. The Board will give further consideration to an agreement with the firm when they meet next week.

Sheriff Randy Houser presented an advertisement for the solicitation of bids for providing jail meals. Bids will be accepted through August 8th. Specifications for the meals are available from the Sheriff's Office.

Commissioners took no action on a request from Sheriff Houser to consider purchasing a patrol unit from the state bid contract.
