

Diller-Odell FFA Sweeps Area Range Judging Titles

(KTNC)--Members of Diller-Odell's FFA swept the competition at the Area Six Range Judging Contest, held Wednesday near Tecumseh.

One-hundred-71 students and eight adults from 11 schools participated in the contest. The competed individually and three-and-four person teams, in junior and senior divisions.
