The Kansas State Fair has received Awards of Distinction representing Agriculture and Communications from the International Association of Fairs and Expositions (IAFE) headquartered in Springfield, MO.

The Kansas State Fair received first place Agriculture Award of Excellence for the Fair's program featuring Fair and Sponsor Joint Exhibit Program (Kansas Energy Expo). There are a total of 21 award categories for the Hall of Honor Communications Awards, each divided into five divisions by attendance.

Judging of these awards are evaluated and judged by a team of industry leaders. These individuals are selected from the membership of the IAFE, which has over 1,200 members from around the globe.
