Soldier Exhibit Coming to Pott Co Fair

(KMZA)--A mobile display created to honor fallen Kansas servicemen for their sacrifice while serving in Iraq and Afghanistan will be featured during the Pottawatomie County Fair beginning Wednesday.

The photo exhibit, "Remembering Our Fallen" will feature seventy-nine military members from Kansas who lost their lives in the War on Terror since 9/11.

There are currently displays finished in twenty-two states representing each fallen serviceman who called that state home.
