Fire Destroys Long Standing Rushville, MO Church (KAIR)--A Rushville, Missouri church, that has stood for over 120 years, was destroyed by a fire Saturday morning.

Rushville Fire Chief Andrew Johnson says his department was notified of the fire shortly after 7:00 at the Short Creek Baptist Church.

Upon arrival, Johnson says firefighters found the church totally engulfed in smoke, and were unable to contain the fire in time.

The church had stood since 1895, and had about 10 to 15 regular members who attended services on Sunday.

Services were held Sunday in the church's parsonage.
