

Winter Storm Warning Cancelled; Advisory Issued
(MSC News)--The Winter Weather Warning issued for much of the loca area has now been downgraded.

The National Weather has instead issued a Winter Weather Advisory, making the change despite an earlier extension of the warning.

* TIMING...PERIODS OF SNOW, SLEET, AND FREEZING DRIZZLE WILL MOVE ACROSS THE AREA THIS MORNING...LIKELY DECREASING BY
THIS AFTERNOON.

* SNOW AND SLEET ACCUMULATIONS...1 TO 3 INCHES OF SNOW ARE EXPECTED...WITH MINOR SLEET ACCUMULATIONS POSSIBLE.

* OTHER IMPACTS...ACCUMULATION OF SLEET, SNOW, AND FREEZING DRIZZLE WILL CAUSE HAZARDOUS TRAVEL CONDITIONS.

PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS...

A WINTER WEATHER ADVISORY MEANS THAT PERIODS OF SNOW...SLEET...OR FREEZING RAIN WILL CAUSE TRAVEL DIFFICULTIES. BE
PREPARED FOR SLIPPERY ROADS AND LIMITED VISIBILITIES...AND USE CAUTION WHILE DRIVING.

* TIMING...INTERMITTENT LIGHT FREEZING RAIN IS EXPECTED EARLY THIS MORNING. THE FREEZING RAIN IS EXPECTED TO PICK UP IN
INTENSITY BY MID TO LATE MORNING...AND THEN TAPER OFF LATE THIS EVENING. SOME SLEET COULD MIX IN OFF AND ON THROUGH
THE DAY.

* ICE ACCUMULATIONS WILL RANGE FROM A FEW HUNDREDTHS OF AN INCH IN WESTERN MISSOURI...TO GREATER THAN A TENTH OF AN
INCH IN EAST CENTRAL KANSAS THROUGH LATE THIS EVENING.

* MAIN IMPACT...ICE ACCUMULATION IS POSSIBLE ON ELEVATED SURFACES LIKE BRIDGES...POWER LINES...AND TREES. WEAK TREE
BRANCHES COULD BREAK UNDER THE WEIGHT OF THE ICE ACCRETION...AND ANY UNTREATED SIDEWALKS AND ROAD SURFACES WILL
BECOME QUITE SLICK.

PRECAUTIONARY/PREPAREDNESS ACTIONS...

A FREEZING RAIN ADVISORY MEANS THAT PERIODS OF FREEZING RAIN OR FREEZING DRIZZLE WILL CAUSE TRAVEL DIFFICULTIES. BE
PREPARED FOR SLIPPERY ROADS. SLOW DOWN AND USE CAUTION WHILE DRIVING.
