Atchison Teacher Remembered (KAIR)--A longtime Atchison teacher, and businessman, has died.

Dan Jackson was 78-years-old at the time of his death Wednesday.

According to his obituary from the <u>Becker-Dyer-Stanton Funeral Home</u>, in Atchison, Jackson began his teaching career in Eureka, Kansas, and began teaching High School English at Atchison's Maur Hill-Mount Academy in 1993.
