Teens Suffer Minor Injuries in Falls City Wreck

(KLZA)-- A two-vehicle wreck in Falls City Saturday evening left two teens with minor injuries.

According to the Falls City Police Department, 17-year-old Kyle Leafty of Falls City was southound on Harlan Street and pulled into a driveway at 601 Harlan. There were four occupants in the Leafty vehicle and three in the Campbell car. Leafty was issued a citation by the investigating officer. Neither alcohol nor drugs were suspected to have been a factor in the wreck.
