

Plea in Sabetha Shooting Case

**(KMZA)--A Dawson, Nebraska man charged in connection with a shooting at the Old Sabetha Lake over the Memorial Day weekend has pleaded no contest to charges.**

**The Nemaha County Attorney's Office says 59-year-old Anthony Leftwich recently entered the plea in Nemaha County District Court to charges contained in an amended complaint of one count each of aggravated battery and criminal threat.**

**Sentencing was set for September 29th.**

**Authorities says Leftwich shot rural Bern resident Thad Lambrecht multiple times early May 29th following an argument at the lake. A handgun was recovered at the scene.**

**Lambrecht was taken to a local hospital with serious injuries and then transported to a Kansas City hospital.**
