

Law Enforcement and Street Updates Presented to Pawnee City Council

**(KLZA)-- Pawnee County Sheriff Jayme Reed met with the City Council in Pawnee City Monday night.**

**Sheriff Reed informed the Council that she has been interviewing candidates for an open Deputy Sheriff position.**

**Reed said she has offered the job to one of the candidates and is waiting to hear back if the offer is accepted.**

**In other business this week the Council approved renewing the pasture lease at the city well site with Todd Albers. Albers rents the 177 acres for \$93.25 per acre, which brings in more than \$16,500 annually to the city.**

**Council members were also reminded to the October 18th Town Hall meeting scheduled for a 7 p.m. start time. The meeting is to discuss the re-evaluated street study by JEO. The company is proposing adding additional streets to the street improvement project. It would include 44 blocks under the proposal.**

**Pawnee City voters will decide during the November 8th General Election whether or not to approve an additional ½ cent sales tax to pay for the needed street repairs.**
