

Fifty Thousand Dollar Donation to Local School

(KLZA)--Two big surprises for Johnson County Central Schools were delivered Wednesday.

Representatives of the Dollar General Corporation presented a pair of \$25,000 checks. One for Johnson County Central Elementary School, and one for Johnson County Central High School.
