Humboldt City Council to Meet Tuesday Evening

The Humboldt City Council will hold its next regular meeting Tuesday evening. The agenda for the 7:00 p.m. session includes a couple items pertaining to the Humboldt Auditorium.

The council will consider an amendment to a contract with the Nebraska Energy Office. Grant funds from the Energy Office have been used to pay for new windows at the Auditorium. The council also plans to discuss repairs to the Auditorium roof.

Several people are scheduled to appear before the council to make various requests. The council will consider approval of a one-day liquor license for the Spirit Shoppe.
