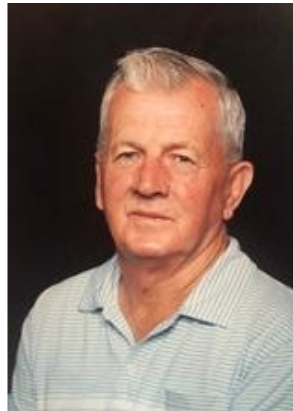


Atchison, KS
