Patricia “Pat” Irene Eggert, 87, of Auburn, Nebraska was born on October 21, 1933 in Nebraska City, Nebraska to John and Clara (Denzin) Strodtman. Patricia attended Unadilla High School and later received her G.E.D. from Auburn High School in December of 1988.
