Gary Allen Bucher, 83, of Auburn, Nebraska was born on February 25, 1938 in rural DuBois, Nebraska to Leo and Alma (Fruhbauer) Bucher. He was one of seven children born to this union. Gary attended Sunny Slope country school and graduated from Humboldt High School with the class of 1956.
