Leonard B. (Lenny) Huninghake, 81, of Seneca, KS, died on Thursday, May 19, 2020, at Crestview Nursing and Residential Living in Seneca.

He was born in Axtell, KS on May 1, 1941, to Herman and Anne Osterhaus Huninghake. He attended St. Mary's School in St. Benedict.

On October 16, 1965, he married Judith M. Wempe at Sts. Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Seneca. After they were married, they lived in the Clear Creek Township.
