Charles T. "Chuck" Garber, Sr., 94, of Sabetha, Kansas died Saturday, April 19, 2014 in Marysville, Kansas. He was born on April 12, 1920 the son of Andrew F. Garber and Anna H. (Hartter) Garber in the Berwick Community.

He attended the Berwick School completing the 8th grade. He worked on the family farm until enlisting in the Army in 1941.
