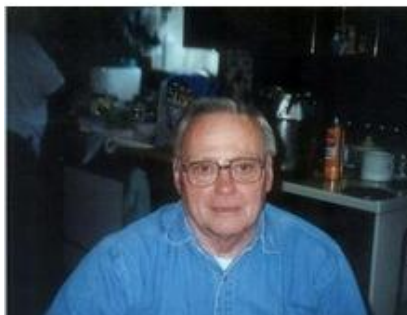


Horton, KS



Fred Johnson Jr., 82 of Horton, Kansas, passed away Friday, May 16, 2014 at his brother's home in Nortonville, Kansas.

Fred was born on October 22, 1931 in Effingham, Kansas the son of Fred and Easter Hall Johnson. Fred was drafted into the U.S. Army after high school.
