Sheriff's Deputy Recovering After Motorcycle Accident (KAIR) -- An Atchison County Sheriff's Deputy is recovering following a motorcycle accident Sunday evening in south Saint Joseph.

According to Atchison County Sheriff John Calhoon, Tim Miller was injured in the accident near Alabama Street on U-S 59 highway.
